The Fourth Annual Pahaquarry Paint Out/Shoot Out

The annual PAHA "Paint Out/Shoot Out" is an outdoor event for photographers and painters. The program is set for Saturday, October 10, starting at 10 a.m., at the B.B. Van Campen/Julia Orthwine Homestead. The property is located inside the Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area (DWGNRA), 2.5 miles south of Millbrook Village, behind the Abraham Van Campen/Jean Zipser Homestead.

The day begins with the painters and photographers meeting for a breakfast reception and registration at the B.B. Van Campen house. PAHA will supply maps and information to help orient the participants to the area. The cost for the event is \$20 per artist/photographer.

Besides the breakfast reception, PAHA will offer a buffet lunch from 12:30 to 2:00 p.m. when the painters and photographers return from their morning activities. After lunch, the participants will set out again to paint and photograph the variety of fabulous spring settings within the Pahaquarry region of Hardwick Township. The event ends around 5:00 p.m.

PAHA offers local venues to the participating artists for their work produced during the "Shoot Out/Paint Out". The rain date for the event is Sunday, October 11.
