We'll be experimenting with techniques for rapid capturing in watercolor of the fleeting effects of light. The morning session will take place at historic Millbrook Village, which offers a variety of architectural and earth-bound subjects. After lunch we will drive a few miles south down the Delaware River to work at Poxono Landing, close to the water's edge. Dress and provisions for a day in the country, to include boots or closed shoes with treads, light and loose fitting long sleeves and pants, a hat, insect repellent and sunscreen. Bring a picnic style lunch and supplies for painting in watercolors outdoors. A list of recommended supplies is available upon request.
