Defining a limited segment of the visual field is a key to effective composition. A good design creates the basic elements on which the artist can build a clear structure. A complex visual field can be tamed by following a few easy strategies, some of which we will explore during the course of the workshop. Open to artists at all levels. The suggested dress and provisions for a day in the country should include boots or closed shoes with treads, light and loose fitting long sleeves and pants, a hat, insect repellent and sunscreen. Bring a picnic style lunch and supplies for painting in watercolors outdoors. A list of recommended supplies is available upon request.
