The artist agrees that Warren County ARTS and the coordinators of this show may photograph the artwork for the sole purpose of marketing the art show.

All artwork must remain on display for the duration of the show.

All works meeting these conditions are eligible for display. Warren County ARTS and PAHA reserve the right to refuse any work considered inappropriate.



DIRECTIONS

The gallery is located at 11 Green Street, Oxford, NJ.

From Southern, Western and Eastern Warren County, go to Washington and take Route 31 North to light in Oxford. Turn right at light onto Wall Street. Driveway to Municipal building is on the right, past the firehouse.

From Northern Warren County, take Route 46 to Route 31 South. At light in Oxford, turn left onto Wall Street. Driveway to Municipal building is on the right, past the firehouse.
